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Communication and Content Sharing

1- Email

- Virtual Backgrounds: Customize your background during video calls.

4- Social Media

- Stories: Temporary posts that disappear after 24 hours.
- Live Streaming: Broadcast live videos to your audience.
- Ads: Promote content and reach a targeted audience.











Cloud storage services provide online storage for files, allowing easy sharing and access from any device.

Key Tools:

- **Google Drive**: Offers 15 GB of free storage with seamless integration with Google services.
- **Dropbox**: Known for its simplicity and cross-platform compatibility.
- **OneDrive**: Integrated with Microsoft Office, providing efficient file management.

- **File Sharing**: Share files and folders with others, with control over permissions.
- **Collaborative Editing**: Multiple users can work on the same document simultaneously.
- **Backup and Synchronization**: Automatically back up files and sync them across devices.
